

BYLAW 6-2011

A BYLAW TO FIX RATES TO BE CHARGED FOR THE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL OF WASTES OR REFUSE, AND TO PROVIDE FOR TRANSFERRING OF ANY UNPAID ACCOUNTS TO THE TAX ROLL

The Council of the Town of Dundurn in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw, including this section:
 - a) "municipality" means the Town of Dundurn;
 - b) "administrator" means the administrator of the municipality.
2. Persons who own or occupy premises being served with the collection, removal, or disposal of solid wastes or other refuse shall pay for such services a charge as set out below:
 - a) Residential - \$ 9.50 per month
 - b) Businesses/Commercial shall be charged as follows:
 - i) Cart - \$ 9.50 per month
 - ii) 3 yd. Bin - \$ 10 per month rent + \$ 19.50 per pick up
 - iii) 4 yd. Bin - \$ 10 per month rent + \$ 26.00 per pick up
 - iv) 6 yd Bin - \$ 20 per month rent + \$ 39.00 per pick up
 - c) Dundurn Housing Authority – contingent on size of bin required
3. Accounts for collection, removal or disposal of solid waste or other refuse, shall cover a period of one month, and shall be rendered on or before the first day of the month next following such period.
4. Accounts for collection, removal or disposal of solid waste or other refuse that are unpaid after the end of the current billing period shall be considered in arrears and the penalty shall be 10% of the arrears per month (billing period) and the service may be discontinued. In the event the service is discontinued, it will not be reinstated until the account is brought to current and all penalties and arrears have been paid in full.
5. Any sum payable to the urban municipality for the collection, removal or disposal of solid wastes and other refuse that remains unpaid on December 31 of the year in which the sum became payable shall be added to, and thereby form part of the taxes on the land and/or buildings in respect of which the collection, removal or disposal was done.
6. If a cart becomes damaged due to misuse or vandalism the account associated with said cart shall be charged \$135.
7. This bylaw shall come into effect on July 1, 2011.
8. That Bylaw 2-2009 be hereby repealed.
