Dear Resident;

Council would like to give you an update on the status of the water project. The Dundurn Rural Water Utility is near completion with their part of the construction for the Town to receive the new water. We are waiting on a manifold to be installed into our water treatment plant that will bring the new water to our reservoir.

At this time we anticipate this manifold to be able to be installed within the next couple of weeks. Council was faced with two options in regards to the delivery timeframe of the new water. The first option would be to create a blend of the current well water and the new "city" water. We have been advised by our engineer that until we can run 100% "city" water we would have a noticeable odour due to the fact that the two water sources have different treatment processes. The second option would be to wait until some of the upgrades are done in the plant and the reservoirs are cleaned out and run 100% "city" water. Council felt that our residents would prefer a fresh start to the new water system and chose the second option which estimates that the new water will be available in January 2012.

The tenders for the water treatment plant upgrades are out and will be awarded soon so that the upgrades can commence within the next few weeks.

We will do our best to keep residents informed of the progress of this exciting project.
