

BYLAW 10-2005

A BYLAW TO CLASSIFY, REGULATE, CONTROL & LICENSE HOME-BASED BUSINESSES

The Council of the Town of Dundurn in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. No person shall carry on a home-based business unless a valid home occupation permit has been obtained from the Town of Dundurn in accordance to the Zoning Bylaw and all amendments to it.
2. No person shall carry on a home-based business unless a valid and subsisting license has been issued in accordance with the provisions of this bylaw.
3. The Administrator of the Town of Dundurn is hereby authorized to issue a license to any person carrying on a home-based business where that person:
 - a) makes application for such license stating the specific nature of the business; and
 - b) tenders with the application, the license fee as set out in section 6 of this bylaw.
4. Every license issued under the authority of this bylaw, unless suspended or revoked, shall expire on the thirty-first (31st) day of December of the year of issue.
5. Every license issued under this bylaw shall be displayed in such a manner that the administrator, bylaw enforcement officer, license inspector, or any peace officer may inspect the license upon entry of the home-based business.
6.
 - a) Subject to subsection 5(b), the fee payable for a license under this bylaw shall be \$ 40.00 per annum.
 - b) Where a license is issued after the 31st day of August in any year, the fee payable under subsection 5(a) shall be reduced by 50 per cent.
7. Licenses are to be renewed by February 1st of each year.

8. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and upon conviction, shall be liable to the penalty proved by the General Penalty Bylaw.
9. This bylaw shall come into effect January 1, 2006.
