

BYLAW NO 2012-6
TOWN OF DUNDURN

**A BYLAW TO REQUIRE EVERY MUNICIPAL ELECTION CANDIDATE TO SUBMIT
A CRIMINAL RECORD CHECK**

The Council of the Town of Dundurn in the Province of Saskatchewan, under the provision of Section 89.1, *The Municipalities Act* & Section 63.1, *The Cities Act*, enacts as follows:

1. It shall be lawful to require every person submitting their nomination for the position of Mayor or Councillor to provide a criminal record check in addition to the nomination paper submitted pursuant to section 46 of *The Local Government Elections Act* at their own expense.
2. No nomination shall be deemed complete and accepted by the returning officer without the criminal record check.
3. Criminal record checks shall be in the form provided by the local RCMP detachment and shall display signature of commanding officer, date and seal.
4. Criminal record checks shall not be more than 3 months old at time of submission.
5. The returning officer or nomination officer shall post in conspicuous place copies of the nominations received and accompanying documentation.
6. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon final reading by Council.
